The Whatcom Humane Society Offers Patriotic Pet Adoption Deal To Celebrate July 4th Holiday

In honor of the July 4th holiday, the Whatcom Humane Society (WHS) is encouraging patriotic citizens to adopt a homeless animal by offering ½ off on the cost of adoption for all “Red, White & Blue” animals available for adoption.

The special adoption offer is valid from June 30th – July 11th.

WHS Community Outreach Director Laura Clark says potential adopters will need to “use their imagination” when they visit the shelter to look for a new pet. “Red animals could include orange cats or kittens, an Irish Setter or a rooster,” says Clark. “White is fairly self-explanatory, but blue could include a grey cat, a dog with blue eyes or perhaps a parakeet”.

The Whatcom Humane Society also encourages potential adopters to visit the shelter and look for animals with a special “*I’m a patriotic pet*” sticker on their kennels. The adoption fee for these animals will also be discounted.
